PART 2 - Special Class Application and Decision Dates for admission to Cashel Community School 2027 / 2028

Please be reminded that, in line with the school’s Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply. Therefore, if a student is seeking a place in the Special Class and is not successful in a given academic year or is on a waiting list for this year, a new application must be made for the following year.

Should your child or young person be placed on a waiting list for a place, their personal data may be shared with the National Council for Special Education (NCSE) for the purposes of planning for the provision of special education placements.

Please note that a letter from the NCSE confirming that the child or young person is known to them and that the child/young person has the required diagnosis and recommendation for a special class for autism is a prerequisite for an application for placement in the special class.
